The Thunder in the Valley Air Show will take place on March 20 - 21, 2010, at the Columbus Airport. The purpose of the air show is to raise funds for the youth in our community and provide fun and recreation for the entire valley area.

The Columbus Airport and the Thunder in the Valley Air Show committee will host the event. It will feature daily exhibits, static aircraft displays, spectacular aerial performances, military fly-bys and various family activities. This year's show will feature more performers and planes than ever, which is certain to boost our attendance to over 30,000 people!

We are now taking reservations for exhibitor space. Spaces this year will be on the flight line and gate entrances. Spaces start at 10 ft. X10 ft. and go up. The cost per space is \$6 per square foot, plus a one-time refundable \$25.00 clean up fee, which is refundable if your space is left clean and free of debris after the show. No electricity will be available and exhibitors are responsible for all necessary equipment for their set-up/display including, tarps, tents, chairs, tables, generator, if needed. We will issue 2 passes and one exhibitor-parking permit to each exhibitor. We can also refer you to a source for any equipment or set up materials you may need.
